THIS MIDWEST COAST IPA TAKES INSPIRATION FROM OUR FAVORITE IPAS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ATLANTIC. THE MALT BILL IS SUPPORTED BY ENGLISH PALE AND CRYSTAL MALTS, WHILE THE HOP BILL RELIES ON AMERICAN CASCADE AND CENTENNIAL FOR STRONG CITRUS AND PINEY AROMAS.
